- Relates a fraction with a denominator of ten to a decimal, using drawings Success Markers (Matrix)

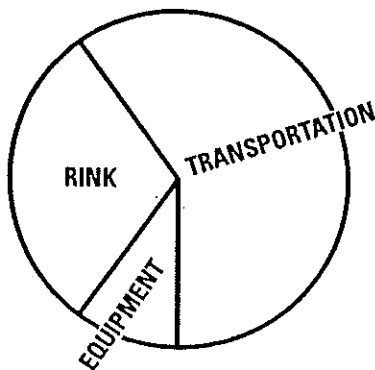
Manage Data and Probability, Level 3
